


Lutheran School to **Open in September**


Registration for the First Lutheran Church's new Christian elementary school will begin next week, accord-ing to Pastor Paul Wenske.

In Islan elementary school will begin next week, according to Pastor Paul Wenske. The school will open in the fall for kindergarteners and first and second graders. Registration dates will be from June 18 to 21 and June 25 to 28 from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. and from June 19 to 16 from 7:30 to 9 p.m. Present plans call for addition of one grade to the school each year. All public school courses will be taught with a religious course emphasizing spiritual values. Teachers will meet the regular state qualifications. The new school building will have a playground and the other modern educational equipment. It is the first Protestant Christian school in the area. A school board, headed by Pete Durst, foreman of Field Shop Service, National Supply, will guide the affairs of the school. Members of the congregation are on the board.
