He was chairman of the Lennox City Community Chest in 1955 and 1956 and is currently serving his second stint as director of the Lennox Chamber of Commerce.

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FIREWORKS SHOW SET TONIGHT

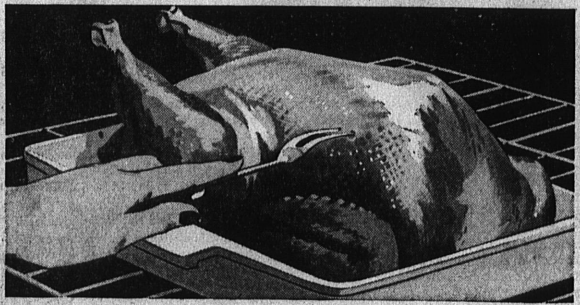

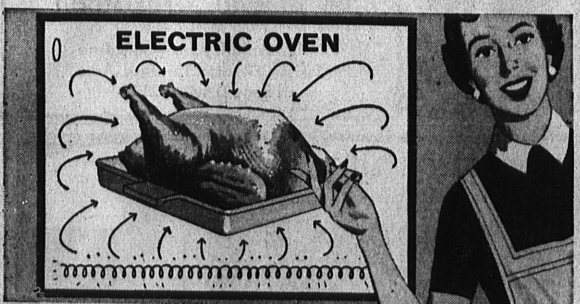

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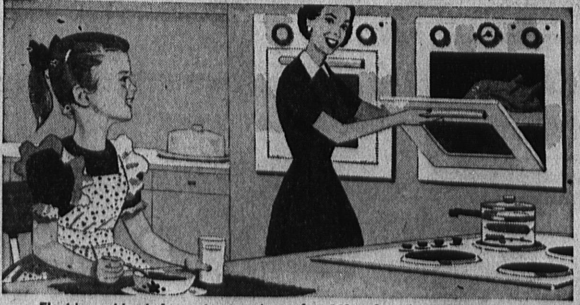
