FINCH LASHES OUT AT INFILTRATION THREAT

Attorney Robert H. Finch, Chairman of the Republican Central Committee of Los Angeles County, has strongly condemned the proposed union maneuver to infiltrate the Republican Party in 1958 in a program to influence the selection of Republicans nominated in the party primaries.

Senator Knowland have sufficient strength within the Republican Party in California that they do not need to rely on "carpetbag Republicans" who think so little of their own political convictions that they would re-register next year to attempt to foist the political attitudes of their leaders onto the Republican Party," Finch said.

Finch made his remarks at a state-wide school of politics conducted over the week end in San Diego by the California State Young Republicans. The county chairman stated that Republicans were interested in "full-time, not part-time" union members in the GOP.

"The statements by Mr. Hagerter serve only to point out the fact that the Republican Party must now develop a strong organization or perish. Only in this way can we resist the pressures of these outside interests and continue to work toward the great goal of the Republican Central Committee in Los Angeles County: the development and promotion of winning candidates in our state legislature and national Congress in 1958."

Finch described the re-registering proposal as "a step which would undermine the traditions of our state and nation in the selection of candidates for public office."

At the same time the Los Angeles Central Committee Chairman declined to comment on the possibility of a Knight-Knowland contest in the primaries, and expressed belief that the proposal of re-registration by Democrats ought to be opposed by either of the two Republican leaders.
