Greeks Loc ATHENS, Greece — With the possible exception of Electherics Venizelos, famed Greek prime minister after World War I, no Greek per-sonality has captivated the imagination of 12 million Greeks as does the Arch-bishop of Cyprus, Makarlos, today, For he is not only the symbol of Cyprus independ-ence from Britain and "encsis," or union with Greece, but he is the rally-ing point of a rising Greek autonalism in the strategic Metterranean. Ever since his student on the Seychelles Islands on the Indian ocean, Archibishop Makarlos continues to receive the bonage and acclamation passant and prince on his nature.

He looked better, more vibrant and en-thusiastic than at any previ-ous visits I had with him here and in Cyprus.
