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ORDINANCE NO. 900

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, CALIFORNIA, ORDERING, CALLING, PROVIDING FOR AND GIVING NOTICE OF A SPECIAL ELECTORAL ASSEMBLY TO BE HELD ON THE 20TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 1957, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF SAID CITY TWO PROPOSITIONS TO INCUR BONDED INDEBTEDNESS BY SAID CITY FOR CERTAIN MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Torrance, California, did on the 15th day of September, 1957, in a written resolution, No. 3289, entitled "RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF TORRANCE, CALIFORNIA, DETERMINING THAT THE PUBLIC INTEREST AND NECESSITY DEMAND THE EXPENDITURE OF \$1,000,000.00 FOR CERTAIN MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENTS AND MAKING FINDINGS RELATING THERETO," which said resolution was duly signed and approved by the Mayor of said city and attorney general of the State of California, the City Clerk of said city;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Torrance, California, does ORDEAIN as follows:

Section 1. That at a special election to be held, and the same is hereby called to be held in the City of Torrance, California, on the 20th day of October, 1957, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of said city two propositions of incurring indebtedness and issuing bonds of said city for the amount hereinafter set forth, and for the objects and purposes set forth in the aforesaid resolution, as follows:

Section 2. That the object and purpose for which each of said indebtedness may be incurred and bonds issued therefor are as follows:

BOND PROPOSITION "A"—PARK AND RECREATION FACILITIES: Shall the City of Torrance incur indebtedness in the principal amount of \$3,000,000 for the purpose of the acquisition and construction by said city of a certain number of improvements of land for park and recreation facilities and other improvements for park and recreation purposes, together with the acquisition and removal of buildings and the acquisition of furniture, furnishings, apparatus, equipment and property necessary for any of the foregoing.

BOND PROPOSITION "B"—PARK AND RECREATION FACILITIES: Shall the City of Torrance incur indebtedness in a certain amount, including the acquisition and improvement of land for park and recreation facilities, the improvement of existing park and recreation sites, the acquisition of land for park and recreation purposes, together with the acquisition and removal of buildings and the acquisition of furniture, furnishings, apparatus, equipment and property necessary for any of the foregoing.

Section 3. That the estimated cost of the municipal improvement described in Bond Proposition "A" in Section 2 hereof is the sum of \$1,000,000, and that the estimated cost of the principal of the indebtedness to be incurred therefor is the sum of \$1,000,000.

That the estimated cost of the municipal improvement described in Bond Proposition "B" in Section 2 hereof is the sum of \$3,000,000, and that the amount of the principal of the indebtedness to be incurred therefor is the sum of \$1,000,000.
