

Work on Alondra Project To Be Started Next Month

Work will commence within 30 days and will transform the southern portion of Alondra Park into a beautifully developed and equipped playground by next spring, Supervisor Kenneth Hahn announced yesterday as the Board of Supervisors awarded a contract for major improvements on the Redondo Beach Blvd side of the park.

Project will include the construction of a new bathroom of 1500 square feet to serve the swimming pool, general park development, landscaping, a children's playground, additional parking, and park lighting.

About four months will be required to complete the job, Hahn stated.

To Develop Area
General development of the area will include landscaping, construction of picnic and beach areas, walls, walks, and fencing.

"Plans call for the construction of one of the finest playgrounds for children anywhere in the country," he said.

Playground will be located in a triangle area southwest of the swimming pool. It will be paved with asphalt, which will be covered with a colored mastic. Specially designed playground equipment, including plastic "bronchos" will be installed in shallow pits, filled with either sand or tanbark for protection of the children.

Walks Planned
Plans also include construction of walks around the western perimeter of the lake and a new comfort station convenient to the new picnic shelter completed last spring.

All improvements being made at the park are in accordance with Supervisor Hahn's program to develop Alondra into one of the finest regional recreational centers in Los Angeles County.

Last year the area east of the lake was developed and improved. Earlier this year the northwestern portion of the park was developed, landscaped, and three baseball diamonds were constructed.

Garden Chatter

The time was never better to plant those Spring flowering bulbs which are available at your local Nursery and Garden Supply Dealer now. The best planting season for them is October until December.

Daffodils and Narcissus are popular and do well in any good garden soil. Full sun or partial shade is good. Tulips may be purchased now and placed in the refrigerator, (not freezer), for two or three weeks. This pre-cooling and the fact that the ground will be cooler then will make your tulips thrive at their best.

Dutch Iris, Sparaxis, Leucjum or Snowflakes may also be planted now. The Dutch Iris are available in four main colors: blue, white, yellow, and bronze. These plants grow tall so give them room. The last two mentioned above grow shorter, and again full sun or part shade is best.

Hyacinths may be purchased and planted now, or you may wish to hold them and plant them along with your tulips. No pre-cooling is necessary on

them. Muscari, or Grape Hyacinth, and Crocus may also be planted now. Muscari is a deep rich blue in color when it blooms and usually crocus is in mixed tones. Freesias, which are very fragrant when in flower are also ready in mixed colors and can be planted now.

A very good combination, and a very popular one as well, is the combination of Ranunculus and Anemones. These bulbs are also available now in mixed shades, are easy to grow, and make wonderful cut flowers when they bloom in the early and late Spring—especially the Ranunculus. Why not pick up some and as soon as they show above ground put in a few more? This will give a good succession of bloom.

Rabies Down In County So Far in 1957

The rabies picture, both in Torrance and Los Angeles County, looks bright so far this year, according to Dr. Roy O. Gilbert, county health officer.

Only 25 rabid animals—22 dogs, one cat, one skunk, and one fox—have been reported in the county this year, compared with 121 last year and a five-year-average of 108.

Torrance itself has not had any rabid animals reported since last Feb. 7.

The health officer said he believed that the widespread adoption of compulsory rabies inoculation for all dogs by many cities throughout the area had helped to reduce the total.

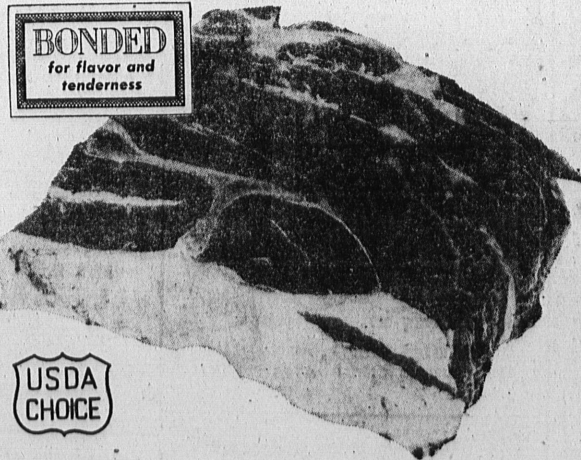
