In comparison with federal cases where convictions have been obtained under the Federal Food and Drug Act, convictions under California law have resulted in uniformivilighter sentences. In the latter instances, fines have been a great deal more leniént, and jail sentences have usually been accompanied by immediate admission to probation.

Under the usual separation of powers, federal law applies only in cases where the fraudulent practitioner has engaged in interstate commerce, and many of the worst offenders in California are careful to confine their activities to practice within the state.
