Giving medicine to a stubborn child is like any other 'do-it-yourself' home project, according to the L.A. County Medical Assn.

A Virginia pediatrician, Dr. Forrest P. White, listed in a retent issue of Today's Health, and American Medical Association publication, some rules and techniques for giving medicine to children.
