Legislative Subcommittees Consider New Budget Bill

new taxes unnecessary.

CONSIDERATION of the budget bill will be a lengthy and laborious process. On the Assembly side, the ways and means committee will break itself down into a number of subcommittees, each of which will hold hearings on the budget items for one department, or one function within a department. Many hours of patient review will be needed before each subgroup can report its findings to the full committee, and more time will elapse before the whole bill reaches the floor of the assembly for a vote on passage.

In the meantime, the Senate finance committee will pursue a similar course in its consideration of the budget.

TO ASSIST the committees and their sub-groups in the review process will be two task forces of budget specialists, one from the department of finance, and the other from our own legislative analysist's office. A detailed examination of the whole budget will be prepared by the analyst, and printed copies of it will be given to every member of the legislature for information and use.

Spokesmen for the finance department will explain, and when necessary defend the budget items. Specialists from the legislative analyst's staff may concur in their recommendations, in which case there is ordinarily no debate over the items involved. When differences between the two agnices do exist, they are thoroughly explored by the committees. . . .

O'HER committees, the revenue and tax groups of the Senate and Assembly will consider the proposals for new and increased taxes. They, too, will have the advice and assistance of specialists from the finance department and our own legislative staff. If past experience can be trusted as a guide, the hearings of these tax committees will attract much greater attendance from the budget itself. There will also probably be much greater public participation in the discussion of the various tax proposals.

This detailed study and ac-tion on both the spending pro-gram and the taxes needed to pay for it is perhaps the most important function of the legpay for it is perhaps the most important function of the legislature. Many people do not stop to think that legislative action on budget and revenues determines the kind and quality of state government that every Californian will get during the coming year, the amount of service he will get, and how much he will pay for it.
