months or even years. The disorder is caused by different species of vegetable parasites (fungi) that invade the outer layer of the scalp, the hair follicle, and eventual-ly the hair shaft itself. In about 10 to 14 days, one or more oval, gravish-white patch-es appear on the scalp. These patches are not visible under ordinary light but can be seen as fluorescent areas when the scalp is examined under a Wood's light (filtered ultra-violet rays) in a completely blacked-out room.

IN THE EARLY stages of the infection, unless a Wood's light is used, the scalp and hair may look normal to the untrained eye, but soon the hair in each patch becomes dull and lifeless and breaks off about ¾-inch above the scalp. This is often the first noticeable sign that an abnor-mal condition exists. The lesion or lesions usually expand to about the size of a dollar and eventually the hair drops off, resulting in bald areas (alo-pecia).

resulting in bald areas (alo-pecia). Generally speaking, there are three types of ringworm that affect the scalp and each is caused by a different fun-gus. The least bothersome is caused by fungus Microsporum lanosum. It is often referred to as the animal type of ring-worm because it is spread chiefly by animal pets, particu-larly infected dogs and cats.



THE TWO so-called human types prevelent in this area are caused by the fungi, Micro-sporum audouini and Tricho-phyton tonsurans. These forms of the disease are usually spread from person to person, although T, tonsurans may also be carried by animals. Most adults and teenagers are resistant to Microsporum au-douini infections. On the other hand, although children are more susceptible, all ages are subject to infection by the Tri-chophyton species. Laboratory examination is required to determine the type of fungus, and the duration of the infection is directly related to the particular type that is found. The animal type, for in-stance, has a usual duration of 3 to 4 months, whereas the hu-man types of the disorder per-sist for at least 5 months.
