Most homes in Los Angeles County are assessed at about 25% of the market value. To for example, if your home is worth 320,000 on a fair market, not including personal property, carpets, draperies, shrubbery, flowers, etc., then it is probably assessed at about \$5,000, and that is the amount on which you pay taxes, disregarding veteran's exemption, if any.


