Assemblyman Advocates Tight Budget

Economy-minded legislators in Sacramento, including Assemblyman Vincent Thomas of San Pedro, expressed determination this week to clamp a tight hold on all unnecessary government spending before beginning a search for new taxes.

Thomas said the members of the legislature were determined to "do everything possible to avoid adding to the burden borne by the people of California upon whom all taxes fall wherever they might be levied."

Evidence of growing protest among the state's citizens, he said, came this week when scores of legislators were "bombed" with tea bags—a 1959 version of the Boston Tea Party—as a protest against proposals to raise taxes or create new taxes.

Citizen organizations are at work in a number of areas of the state, it was pointed out, leading the "grass roots opposition to reckless spending."

"State taxes, in their final application, are local," Thomas said.
