NOTICE OF SPECIAL AN-
NETION ELECTION IN
TRACT NO. 2546, SOME-
TIMES KNOWN AS "CLIF-
TON HEIGHTS," TERRI-
TORY PROPOSED TO BE
ANNEXED TO THE CITY OF
REDONDO BEACH AND RE-
FERRED TO IN PETITION
FOR ANNEXATION AS
"LOS ANGELES COUNTY
ISLAND STRIP."

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a special election will be held on April 28, 1959, in a portion of Tract No. 2546 of Los Angeles, as shown on Sheet No. 2 thereof, as recorded in Book 26, pages 4 and 5 of Maps, in the office of the County Recorder of said Los Angeles County, California, sometimes known as "Clifton Heights," and referred to in the petition for annexation to the City of Redondo Beach as "Los Angeles County Island Strip," for the purpose of voting on the question of whether or not said territory, which is hereinafter particularly described, shall be annexed to the said City of Redondo Beach.

That the date of said election shall be April 28, 1959.

That the proposition to be submitted to the electors of said district or territory proposed to be annexed to the City of Redondo Beach shall be:

"Shall a portion of Tract No. 2546 in Los Angeles County, referred to as 'Los Angeles County Island Strip' and also sometimes known as 'Clifton Heights,' which is particularly described in Ordinance No. 1673 of said City, be annexed to the City of Redondo Beach?"

That the boundaries of the territory so proposed to be annexed to the City of Redondo Beach, California, are specifically described as follows:

That portion of Tract No. 2546, as shown on Sheet No. 2 thereof, recorded in Book 26, at pages 4 and 5 of Maps, in the office of the County Recorder of Los Angeles, California, and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the southwest corner of Lot 11, Block 19, of Tract No. 2546, which corner is also a point on the City boundary of the City of Redondo Beach as same existed on November 20, 1956; thence northerly along the said City boundary and following the same boundary in all its various courses and distances back to the point of beginning.

That the name by which the territory may be indicated upon the election ballot is a portion of Tract No. 2546 in Los Angeles County, referred to as "Los Angeles County Island Strip" and also sometimes known as "Clifton Heights."

Electors voting at said election shall stamp a cross (X) in the voting square after the word "Yes" or after the word "No," following the question stated on the ballot. Cross (X) marks shall be made on ballot only with rubber stamp, never with pen or pencil. All marks except the cross (X) are forbidden. All distinguishing marks or erasures are forbidden and make the ballot void. If an elector wrongly stamps, tears or defaces the ballot, it shall be returned to the inspector of election and another obtained.

If an elector shall stamp a cross (X) in the voting square after the printed word "Yes," the vote of such elector shall be counted in favor of the annexation of the territory referred to in such question to the municipal corporation named therein; and if an elector shall stamp a cross (X) in the voting square after the printed word "No," the vote of such elector shall be counted against such annexation.

That for the purpose of holding said election there has been established one voting precinct, consisting of City of Los Angeles General Election Precincts, Clifton Numbers 1, 2 and 3, and the polling place thereof shall be in the rear of residence at 912 Ynez Avenue in said County territory.

That the polls of said election on said election date shall be open from 7:00 o'clock A.M. and shall remain open continuously from said time until 7:00 o'clock P.M. of said day, when said polls shall be closed.
