ORIGINALLY the zone in question — which serves as a demarcation area between heavy industry and an estab-lished residential area — came into the spotlight last year when the planning commission initiated action to rezone a strip of land south of Mon-terey for multiple units or apartments. The action was later dropped. While, the ac-tion was under way, the Chans-lor-Western Oil & Develop-ment Co., a subsidiary of the Santa Fe Railroad, had agreed to the 100-foot buffer, which was recommended by the plan-ning commission. It was to have included heavy landscap-ing and provision for executive parking only. The proposed 100-foot buffer zone was halved by council vote early this year when proposals for development of the property were considered.
