

## **Public Indifference to Polio** Shots Shocks Medical Circles

Approximately 72 million people in the United States have been vaccinated against poliomyelitis since the vaccine became available in 1955. Although this is a remarkably large n um ber of immunizations, about 98 million Americans are yet to be vaccinated against the disease. Indeed, public indifference to the protection offered by the poliovaccine is considered something of a phenomenon in medical circles.

Despite some misunderstandings, and misgivings, in the earliest days after the Salk vacine became available, the vacine has proved remarkably effective in preventing the paralytic form of the disease. More than 430 million doses have been given in the United States and other countries, and the individuals who were vaccinated three years ago still enjoy adequate protection.

UNFORTUNATELY, the 98 million people in the United States who re main unvaccinated-protected to a degree by those who are, provide a large reservoir of potential polio victims. Last year there were tims. Last year there were that occurred in 1957. However, the number of cases in either of these years is smaller than the incidence in any of the previous 15.
