

# Dr. McClure Named Director Of Music for St. Andrew's

Appointment of Dr. Richard F. McClure as church organist and choir director for St. Andrew's Episcopal Church was announced here yesterday by the Rev. Mr. Hugh R. Percy, rector of the church.

Dr. McClure will assume his duties at the Sunday services, succeeding Mrs. Albert Anderson, who had asked to be relieved of the assignment.

The new director of music for St. Andrew's has been active in church music for the past 23 years, starting as organist in a Presbyterian church in Pittsburgh, Pa., when he was 17.

for the College Church while attending Washington and Jefferson in Pennsylvania; Woodland Presbyterian Church in Philadelphia; St. Andrew's Episcopal Church in Pittsburgh; Covenant Presbyterian Church in Detroit; and the Trinity Episcopal Church in San Francisco.

He studied the organ under the late Ralph Kinder, an outstanding pipe organ composer, teacher, and recitalist.

More recently, he was organist for St. Francis Episcopal Church of Palos Verdes from 1953 until 1956. Since that time, he has devoted much of his time to the annual production of Handel's "Messiah" at

St. Francis, and plans to continue that work this winter in addition to his duties at St. Andrew's.

"WE ARE going to knock ourselves out," McClure said in reference to his assignment at St. Andrew's.

He said he would continue the junior choir in an effort to develop future choir voices. He also will seek the development of an outstanding adult choir.

On of his first assignments is to line up at least four soloists, he said.

No immediate changes in schedules are anticipated, Dr. McClure said. Junior choir practice will continue to be
