

Los Angeles exchange service in Torrance, Lomita, Wil-ngton and San Pedro is identified by the NEvada-6 number. The new SPruce-5 number will be served from the central office at 1418 Broad Avenue in Wilmington.

More than 800 NEvada-6 telephone users will be affected

New SPruce-5 telephone numbers will be mailed to local customers prior to the change of prefixes. FAirfax telephone in Torrance will not be affected by the number change, he said.
