MacFaden Appointed to Law Library

Law partner of former Torrance City Attorney James Hall has been named a trustee of the Los Angeles County Law Library.

William E. MacFaden of Redondo Beach will represent the board of supervisors as a trustee on the library board.

Supervisor Burton C. Chace made the recommendation for MacFaden's appointment Tuesday. The library board of trustees is composed of three superior court judges, one municipal court judge and the chairman of the board of supervisors or an attorney appointed by the chairman.

MacFaden, partner in the law firm of MacFaden, Brown and Hall, was the youngest police judge in the United States, is past president of the Inglewood-South Bay Bar Assn., Rotary, Junior Chamber of Commerce, Redondo Chamber of Commerce, president of the South Bay YMCA and last year received the "Citizen of the Year" award in Redondo Beach.

Large Branch Library for South Urged

One large library to serve the south Torrance area served by South High School was recommended by the Torrance Library Board Monday night.

After considerable discussion of the merits of having one large library for an area instead of a number of smaller neighborhood libraries, the board, by a 3-2 vote, recommended the larger set-up.

A minimum size of 3000 square feet was recommended for the new building. At the present time, the area is served by the Waveria branch, smallest of the city's three libraries. The city also had been studying plans to build another branch library in the Hollywood Riviera section, either by El Retiro Park or Riviera School.

The city operates its libraries under contract to Los Angeles County, but the buildings are owned by the city.

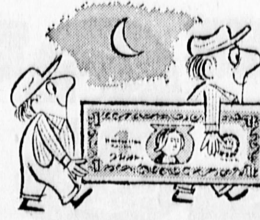
The board also voted to work on a master plan of libraries for the city.
