Beasley Makes Strong Bid for Seat on Council

J. A. "Jay" Beasley, member of the city planning commission, is a candidate for election to the Torrance city council on April 8.

The Walteria resident said he feels south Torrance needs more direct representation since citizens last fall voted to increase council membership from five to six plus a mayor.

Beasley, whose efforts helped to give Walteria one of the finest parks in the South Bay area, will run on a plat-form of more adequate park-recreation facilities for all sec-tions of Torrance.

Long active in city affairs,

he was one of the original members of the recreation commission, remaining four years. He served three years on the planning commission on the planning commission before appointment recently to a four-year term, and was on the committee to help greater Torrance celebrate its selec-tion as an All-America City. Beasley aided Jim Whitmer in organizing the Walteria Business Men's Club nine years ago and was its first and fourth

Owner of a feed and garden supply business in Walteria until 1950, Beasley since has been em-ployed by Felker Manufacturing Co. of Torrance as foreman of the electroplating depart-ment. The firm makes dia-

mond saws and drills.

Beasley's wife, Fannie, has been a kindergarten teacher in the Torrance Unified School District since 1946. They have three children, James, 19, a sophomore geology major at El Camino; Priscilla Ann, 16, a junior at North Torrance High; and Carol Jean, 11, a fifth grader at Walteria Elementary School. The family resides at 24240 Ocean Ave., Walteria.
