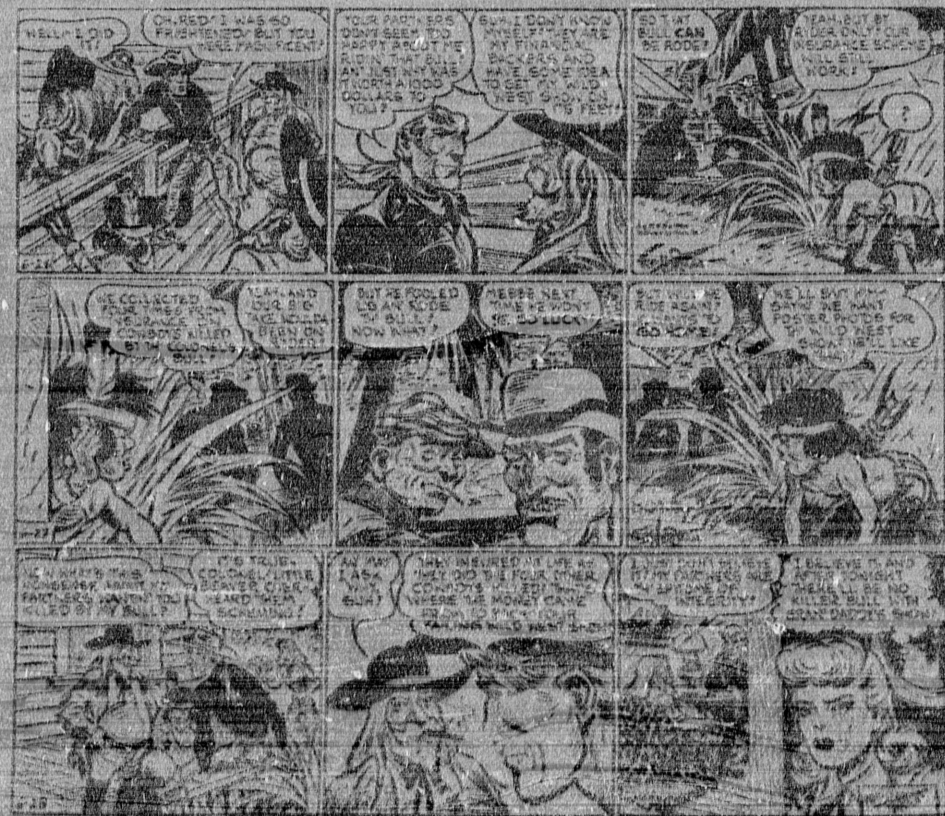

Smelting Firm Scholarship Goes to Youth

W. D. Schwartz, president of U. S. Pacific Smelting Company, announced this week that Walter Arthur Sapp, 18-year-old graduating senior from North High School, has been awarded the 1958 Pacific Smelting Foundation Educational Scholarship. A scholarship plan was set up in 1957 by the Pacific Smelting Foundation exclusively for graduating seniors in the Torrance school system who desire to enroll in a university to obtain a scientific or engineering degree. The recipient of this scholarship is chosen on the basis of scholastic record, character, citizenship, leadership, aptitude for a science or engineering career and general educational outlook. Each applicant presented a written report of his qualifications and was given a personal interview by a committee from the Pacific Smelting Foundation. Applications were received from North High and Torrance High. The Scholarship provides Sapp with \$500 a year for five years, or a total of \$2,500 to assist him in paying his college expenses. He is permitted to attend any accredited college or university of his choice. It is his intent to enter the Department of Mathematics at the University of California in Los Angeles. The youth is the son of John N. Sapp, 4808 Merrill St., and Mrs. Mildred B. Downer.
