

### Civil Defense Warden for Area Transfers to Sheriff's Office



Charles Deck, who lives at 20513 Tuluca Ave., left his post as Deputy County Warden for Civil Defense this week to accept an assignment in the Sheriff's Department. Deck has headed up local Civil Defense activities for more than two years.

Reviewing his Civil Defense activities before leaving that office, Deck said he spoke to an average of five groups a week during the two years, and helped in the training of 2451 volunteer Civil Defense Wardens. The wardens attended 18-hour courses under the program.

The training these volunteers received will be like money in the bank for the communities in which they reside in case of any type of disaster," Deck said.

Among the phases of the training program were:  
 1. How to help law enforcement by assisting in directing traffic.  
 2. How to assist fire departments, and instructions in putting out home fires.  
 3. Most care of displaced populations.  
 4. Registration of displaced persons.
