

Local Residents Plan Attendance At Bowl Concert

It will be Torrance Night at the Hollywood Bowl on Friday Night, Aug. 1, it was announced today by President Fred Mill of the Chamber of Commerce. This is the first time it has been presented to the people of Torrance and neighboring communities.

"Disneyland comes to the Hollywood Bowl" will be the title of the evening's entertainment, which is a Family Night. Mill said his group's special events committee, under J. H.

Wagot, is handling reservations through arrangement of Mrs. F. F. Forre of Torrance, who is active in the Hollywood Bowl Auxiliary.

A choice block of seats have been reserved in the Starline Section of the Bowl for the family project, and reservations may be obtained at the Chamber office at 1345 El Prado, or through Mrs. Forre. For those not wishing to "fight" Bowl traffic, and save parking fees, arrangements

have been made for round-trip bus transportation. Buses will leave the Chamber of Commerce office at 6 p.m.

Chamber officials urged family groups to bring a picnic supper and eat in the Bowl.
