Rev. Stanton Returned to Local Pulpit

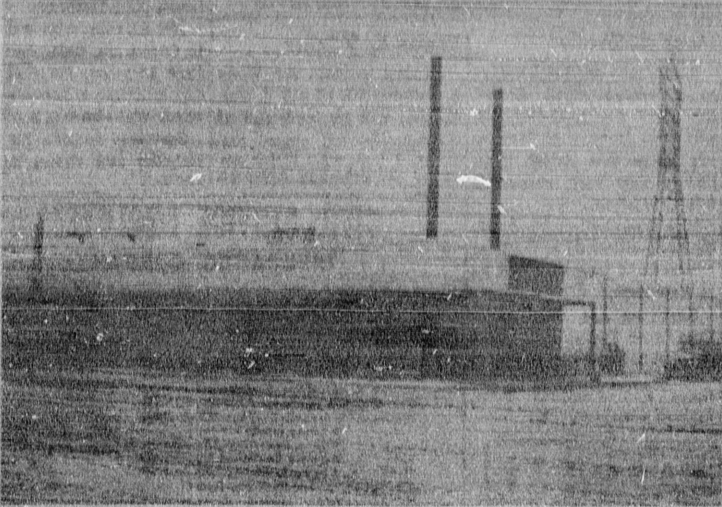
Rev. Walter Stanton, pastor of the Central Evangelical United Brethren Church, has been returned as minister for the sixth year.

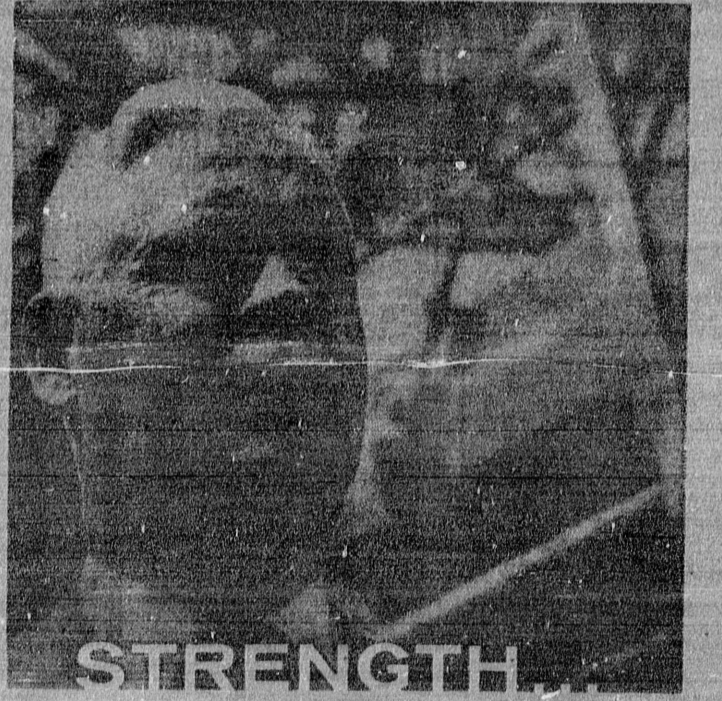
