Six Months Building Permit Valuation Passes \$13 Million

Building permit valuations in June passed the one million dollar mark again to bring the six month totals of 1958 to \$13,834,794, it was announced yesterday by Building Superintendent Lee Schlers.

June permits were distributed among new homes, apartments, commercial and industrial buildings, and alterations. Two new single-family dwellings were authorized and one duplex unit. Eight commercial buildings and one industrial building were given permits during June as well as the El Retiro Park library and the Scout Center. Forty-one other buildings were started during the month.

Among the larger permits was one for \$190,000 to John Howard for a bowling and recreation center at 24800 Crenshaw Blvd.

The Coachella Land Co. was given a permit for a \$220,000 market building at 2750 Pacific Coast Hwy., and the Union Carbon & Carbide Co. a \$20,000 permit for a public storage facility.

The Scout Center at 2565 Plaza Del Amo was valued at \$45,500 and two commercial stores at 3836-40 Sepulveda

Blvd. at \$20,000. The swimming pool business was booming during June, the reports show.
