

Uncommitted Group Could Play Key Role in Future

Despite a popular belief that the world is shaped like an orange, with one half committed to the United States and the other to Russia, there is a third group of uncommitted human beings who, if they were united, could set the rest of the world "packing".

So declared Dr. Ralph J. Kaplan, soldier, linguist and commentator in an address before the Torrance Rotary club at their regular meeting Wednesday. Dr. Kaplan was introduced by Sam Levy, business and civic leader.

between the free and captive worlds, Dr. Kaplan insisted that the main issue is people. The uncommitted millions are the audience.

The so-called Arab world occupies 1 1/2 times the space of the United States by peoples whose life expectancy is only 35 years. Naturally they are going to try to get all they can out of life in that short time. Russia has made these people secure in the belief Russia won't fight them because they have given Nasser more than \$400,000,000 worth of military supplies.

Dr. Kaplan said that the average Arab has from \$35 to \$200 take home pay a year and lives in a medieval economy with the country's cotton crop pledged for the next 10 years to the Russians who could, at any time they please, dump it on the world market.

The speaker charged Nasser with being determined to destroy anything in the Middle East that isn't Arab. Israel is committed to America, he maintained, and will remain so because our philosophies of government and individual freedoms are parallel.

Dr. Kaplan was born in 1913 in Riga, Latvia, a country now behind the Iron Curtain. He was educated on the continent and in England. During World War II he served as an infantry officer with the British Middle East force and he was action in Syria, the western desert and Europe.

During the Arab-Israel war as an officer in charge of an important section of education in the Israel Army, he introduced for the first time in any army a complete system of education by correspondence, auto-study.
