The war over, Charlton set his project into motion. He raised the necessary money, contracted for construction of the tiny ship, supervised and dispatched the thousands of details that arose and, finally, sailed aboard ship when the Mayflower II set out from England for Plymouth, Mass. It was his first voyage under sail.

The 3,831-mile voyage required 64 days and was the subject of worldwide interest. Now on exhibit in Miami, the Mayflower II ultimately will be returned to Plymouth where it will be permanently berthed as part of the Plymouth Plantation now being re-created on a 100-acre site just north of Plymouth.
