Allocation of \$200,000 Aid to City money to the City of Torrance was approved today by Chairman Burton W. Chace of the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisor.

The money, placed in the budget by Chace at the request of the Torrance City Council, will be used to widen and improve Lomita Boulevard between Hawthorne and Crenshaw Boulevards, a distance of approximately one mile.

The improvement will provide four traffic lanes in addition to two lanes of parking and appurtenant drainage structures.

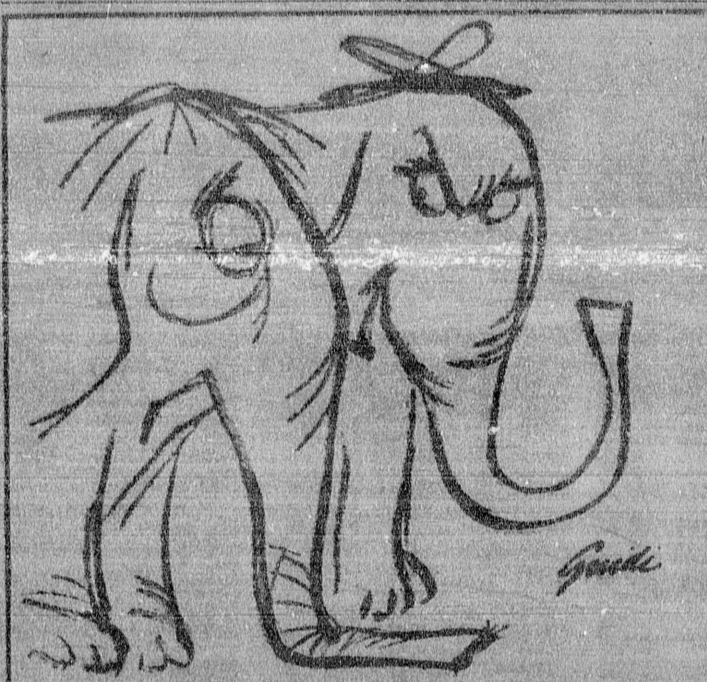
