

### Children to Register for Classes in Dog Training

A series of children's dog training classes will begin in the near future at Walteria Park.

The sessions are to be held on Saturday mornings from 9:30 a.m. to 12 noon for seven weeks beginning Aug. 2, and ending Sept. 13. Training will be handled by experienced members of the Santa Bay Dog Obedience Club of Torrance recreation department. Roy Smith, noted Southland dog trainer, will supervise the leaders.

**Conditions Told**  
To be eligible for these classes these conditions should be met: children between the ages of 8 and 14 years old; dogs should be at least six months old and no more than 12 years old; the child must provide proper training equipment (announced at the first meeting on Aug. 2); the final eligibility will depend on a combination of the child and the dog. A child must be capable of handling his pet.

**Fee Charged**  
There is a small registration fee per child; all money collected is used to cover the cost of the diplomas and trophies awarded at the graduation ceremonies on Sept. 13. Parents will be required to register, sign a waiver and attend all classes with their child.

Registration will be at Walteria Park, Aug. 2 at 9:30 a.m.; the maximum number allowed in each class will be 25.
