Bus Service Taken Over

The California Public Utilities Commission today authorized Cross Town Suburban Lines to acquire Sunset Stages Aug. 4.

Sunset Stages serves Redondo Beach, Manhattan Beach, Hermosa Beach, a part of Torrance, Hawthorne, Lawndale, and Inglewood. Cross Town, whose corporate name is Southern Cities Transit, Inc., operates between Compton, Bellflower, Downey, Huntington Park, Whittier and La Mirada.

In approving the transfer, the Commission said "it appears that Sunset Stages is encountering difficulties in maintaining the quality of service it has heretofore rendered and is desirous of retiring from the passenger stage business."

Fire Station to Go to Highest Bidder Aug. 21

Auction sale of the County's old abandoned Fire Station Six at 2240 Lomita Blvd. was set yesterday by Chairman Burton W. Chase of the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors for 9 a.m., Aug. 21.

At that time, interested buyers may appear before the board of supervisors at the hearing room in the Hall of Records, Los Angeles, and present their offers.

Last April the property, consisting of 5,458 square feet, zoned C-3, and improved with a brick fire station and small detached kitchen, was declared excess by County Fire Chief Keith Klinger.

The county engineer subsequently reported that the appraised value of the land and buildings for resale purposes is \$12,500.
