Half of State Uses MWD Water

Nearly one-half of the entire population of the State of California is now dependent upon the Colorado River Aqueduct for a supplemental water supply, it was revealed today by Joseph Jensen, chairman of the board of directors of the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California.

The tremendous importance of the Colorado River Aqueduct to the economic welfare of Southern California is clearly evidenced by the phenomenal growth of the district since the completion of the aqueduct in its initial development in 1911, Jensen declared.

Torrance is one of the 13 original cities of the Metropolitan Water District and is represented on the MWD Board of Directors by George W. Stevens. There are now 37 members of the Board of Directors of the district. All members and officers of the board serve without salary.

Hawaiian Air Tour Set for April 11

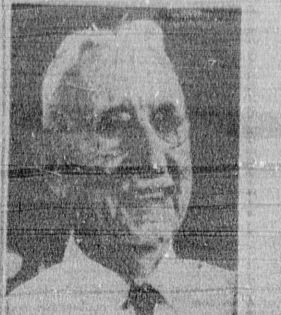
