

### Coed at 78 Invited to Display Work

At an age when many senior citizens contentedly resign themselves to retirement, Mrs. Mabel Stevens, a 78-year-old coed who enrolled in her first course in ceramics at El Camino College last semester, has now achieved status as an international art exhibitor.

Noting the innate talents of the septogenarian in his class last spring, instructor Joseph Gadden of the college art department encouraged Mrs. Stevens to desert the usual pattern of assignments followed by beginning students in ceramics.

The artistically-inclined student steadfastly persisted in completing all assignments

while adding an inventive touch here and there, and soared ahead simultaneously with projects of her own selection.

MRS. STEVENS' work first attracted attention of classmates and art instructors. Later her work was displayed in an El Camino College art exhibit. Recognition of the Senior Citizens group in Los Angeles led to increased publicity of Mrs. Stevens' talents.
