

Blessing of Soul Sunday Sermon Topic

"Let all those that seek thee be magnified." This verse from Psalms is the Golden Text of the Lesson Sermon on "Soul" in all Christian Science churches Sunday.

In a sermon to be read from "Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures" Mary Baker Eddy writes, "Soul has infinite resources with which to bless mankind, and happiness would be more readily attained and would be more secure in our keeping, if sought in Soul. Higher enjoyments alone can satisfy the cravings of immortal man. We cannot circumscribe happiness within the limits of personal sense" (p. 60).

This passage correlates Jesus' words as recorded in the Gospel of Luke (12:31,32), "But rather seek ye the kingdom of God; and all these things shall be added unto you. Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom."

Presbyterians to Break Ground For New Residential Building

Presbyterians of the Southland will take another forward step looking toward the care of people of retirement age when ground is broken on Sunday at 3:30 p.m. marking start of construction of Royal Oaks Manor, designed to accommodate around 200 persons.

The ceremony will take place on the 18 1/2-acre site of the \$2 1/2-million project at 1763 Royal Oaks Dr. in Duarte. The public is invited. Royal Oaks Manor, scheduled for completion in the early fall of 1959, will be the second residential development of the Southern California Presbyterian Homes, non-profit corporation of the church in this area. The first home, The White Sands of La Jolla, which opened two years ago, is now fully occupied and has a large waiting list of future residents.

The new retirement home in Duarte will contain approximately 125,000 square feet of usable floor space, and will include a wide variety of various-sized living areas, in addition to larger rooms for

centrally located chapel. Presiding at the ground breaking Sunday will be Max Eddy, U. L. president of the Homey board of trustees and associate in the law firm of Gibson, Dunn and Crutcher, of Los Angeles.
