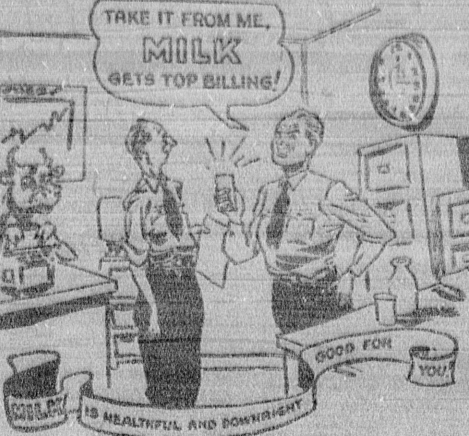

**Torrance Bowl To Be Closed**

**Tag Returns Shed Light On Mysterious Albacore**

Two more speedy lengths, tagged by the California Department of Fish and Game, have spanned the vast Pacific to shed new light on a life history long thought impossible to record.

These gamesters traveled several thousand nautical miles to participate in the ocean fishery of two continents.

Department marine biologists tagged them near the California coast, one in Sept., 1956, and one in July, 1957. Both were caught off Japan in June 1958 and tags returned to the Department by Japanese fisheries agencies.
