

Spiritually Sound Love Sunday Topic

Do you know that it is spiritually sound to love yourself, if it is done in the right way? The extremes of egotism and self-effacement are not true forms of self-expression—the first offends others with its arrogance and rudeness, and the second deprives a person of contributing all that he could to the world's good, according to Rev. Albert H. Cameron, assistant minister of the Redondo-Torrance Church of Religious Science.

Religious science teaches the true meaning of the self as the expression of God—and loving God includes the loves of God's expression both in yourself and others. That this concept can free people from fear and from false modesty will be the subject matter presented by Rev. Cameron Sunday at the regular 11 a.m. services in Redondo.

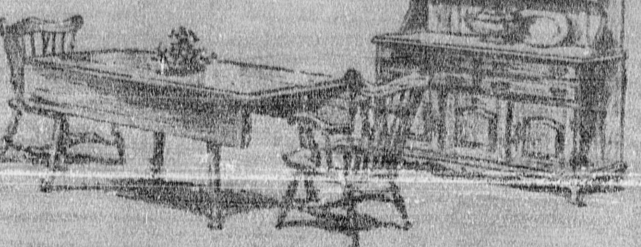

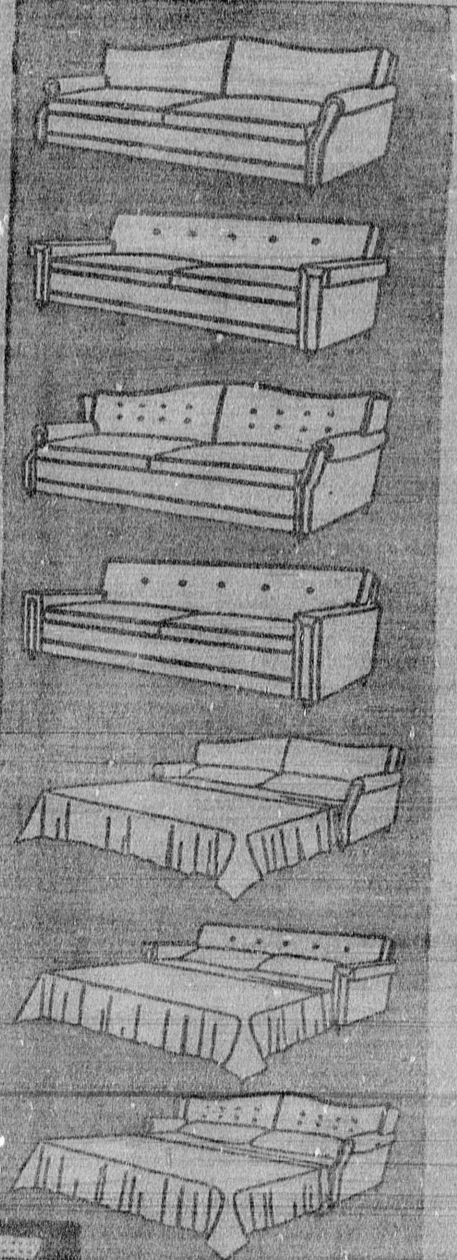
