Law in Action

AN ARTIFICIAL PERSON
Within limits the law gives a corporation the right to act like a "person". It is a "citizen" of the state, it may sue and be sued.

You may think the right to be sued is a dubious one. Yet if you could not sue a corporation, its credit would not be worth much.

A corporation exists over and above its stockholders. A contract for its benefit need not be one to benefit the stockholders. As a rule, one may not make a claim against a stockholder, but may collect only from the corporation. (Though main shareholders often go on notes for small corporations and thus assume liability).

Three or more persons may form a corporation. "Articles of Incorporation" set out (1) its name, (2) its purpose, (3) the county where its main business office will be, and (4) the names of its three directors.

The articles also tell what the scope and limits on its different kinds of shares and its holders are, the directors' and shareholders' powers, and the amount of any stock series if any issues. You file the articles with the Secretary of State and the county clerk.

A corporation as an "artificial person" may do many things: It may (1) sue and be sued in any court; (2) make by-laws; (3) name and pay officers or agents; (4) qualify to do business outside California; (5) assume debts, make contracts, etc., to further its business; and (6) borrow money, and give money to charities, etc.

A corporation must hold a shareholders' meeting once a year to elect directors, make reports, or take up proposals.
