

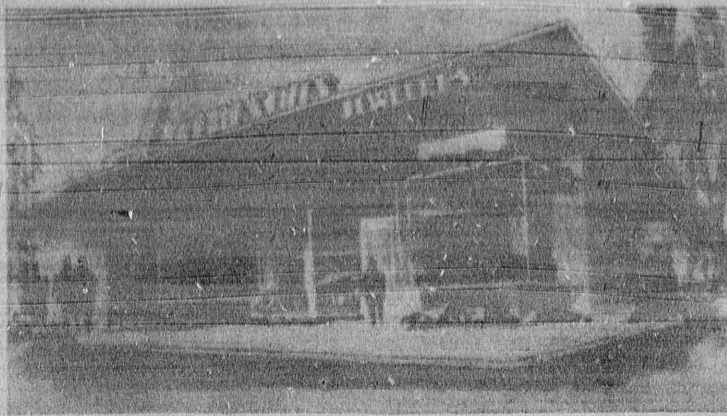
Fun 'N Fashion Show Sponsored
