Powers with a testimonial dinner at 7 p.m. Tuesday, Sept. 30 at the Plush Horse. Prior to the dinner, a reception for the Lt. Governor will be held at 6:15 p.m.

State, county and Torrance area city and civic officials will be invited to attend, Mrs. Aulen F. Bush, general chairman of the dinner said. Invited to participate with the Torrance officials in the testimonial will be representatives of the following cities: Palos Verdes, Rolling Hills, Hermosa Beach, Manhattan Beach, Redondo Beach, El Segundo, Rolling Hills Estates, Gardena, Inglewood, Lennox and Westchester.

Invitations to Governor Powers will be made to honor his 33 years of public service. In 1925 he was elected Minute Clerk of the State Senate and served in that position until 1932.

Elected to the State Senate from the first Senatorial District in 1932, he was re-elected consecutively in 1936, 1940-44-48 and 1952. Powers was elected President Pro Tempore of the Senate in 1947 and re-elected each legislative session until becoming Lt. Governor in 1953.

A native of California, and a cattle rancher by occupation, he is married to the former Marie Street. They have two children, Jane and Franklin (Jack) Powers, who manages the Powers "U" Ranch.
