

Lutherans To Break Ground At New Site

Preparatory to the construction of a new church, ground-breaking services will be conducted next Sunday, Sept. 14, by the Lutheran Church of the Good Shepherd. It is announced by the Rev. Gerald W. Gard, pastor.

Also will be the congregation's first Rally Sunday, which will begin with Sunday School at 9:30 a.m. At 10:45 a short introductory service will be held at Anza Elementary School, 21400 Ellinwood Dr., the present place of worship for the congregation and Sunday School.

Following the opening service the congregation will proceed to the three-acre church site at the corner of Victor St. and Torrance Blvd. for the ground-breaking rites. The pastor will officiate, and representatives of the men, women, young people, and children in the congregation also will participate.

Construction of the house of worship and Sunday School unit is scheduled to begin immediately. Contractor for the project is Hans Roe, South San Gabriel, and Edward D. Davies, Pasadena, is the architect. The Lutheran Church of the Good Shepherd was organized a year ago as a home mission project of the Evangelical Lutheran Church, which is supplying the new congregation with funds required for its construction project.
