California Highway Patrol Commissioner B. N. Caldwell today urged all drivers to review traffic regulations governing conduct when approaching or passing school buses. Now that school has reopened, we are again receiving complaints from school bus drivers that some motorists are not complying with the school bus stopping law. Caldwell explained. Specifically, the law requires that motorists must stop and remain standing whenever a school bus displays flashing red lights. These lights are mounted near the top of the bus, two in the front and two at the rear. The law provides that the bus driver may use the flashing red lights only when a student must cross a street or highway to board the bus or after alighting from the bus. When these red lights are not flashing, it is safe to pass a stopped bus, having due regard for traffic and for any children who may be in the vicinity of the bus, Caldwell added. The only exception to the stopping requirement occurs when there are separate roadways. A motorist bound in the opposite direction on the opposing roadway may proceed without stopping when the red lights are flashing.
