Continuation School Drops Sat. Classes

Saturday continuation school classes will be dropped, and students who formerly attended these classes will be allowed to attend regular adult school classes, the Torrance Board of Education decided Tuesday night.

High costs and low attendance were cited for the action. Some 100 16- to 18-year-old students will be eligible for adult school classes. These include students who must work, married students and others who dropped out of school for various reasons. Officials said a wider selection of courses can be offered in adult school and that a better program, at a cheaper cost, could be offered for students who want to get a high school diploma. Students who want to take continuation school classes will be granted permits to enter nearby districts which have the program.

Plans Approved for Last Unit of North High School

Final plans for the last unit of construction at North High School were approved by the Torrance Board of Education Tuesday night, and bids will be sought within a month. Officials hope that most of the facilities, which will cost an estimated \$1,350,000, will be ready for use by September, 1959. This is the fourth unit of construction at NHS. PLANNED IN the North High construction are additions to the administration, library, multipurpose (cafeteria) and music buildings, as well as two buildings containing 13 classrooms. These will include special rooms for homemaking, office practice, speech and drama, journalism and general science. Funds for this project will be the last bond money authorized by the voters in 1955.

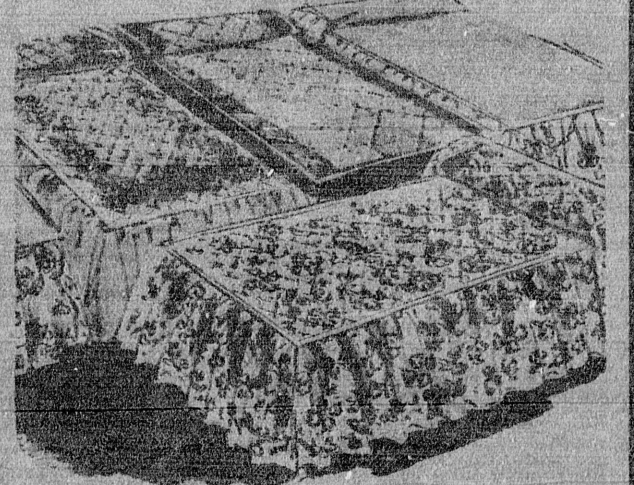

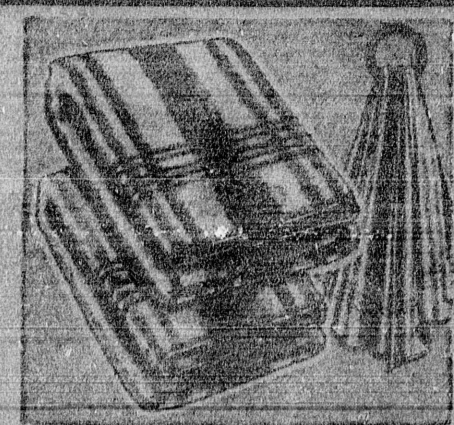
