

# Lutherans Break Ground at Good Shepherd Site To Be Shown At Pre-Natal Class

With the construction of a new church in Torrance beginning last Monday, Sept. 22, the Lutheran Church of the Good Shepherd conducted its ground-breaking services on Sunday, Sept. 14. The congregation's first unit, which is now under construction at 21100 Victor St. just off Torrance Blvd., will include a house of worship, a Sunday School unit, and the church offices.

Officiating at the ground-breaking rites was the Rev. Gerald W. Garlid, pastor of the congregation. Introductory services were held at Anza Elementary School, the congregation's present place of worship, where the pastor spoke on the theme, "This Sacred Ground."

At the church site the men, women and children of the congregation were represented in the ground-breaking by Howard M. Donhowe, president of the congregation; Mrs. A. C. Andersen, president of the Lutheran League; Robert R. Eng, president of the Luther League; and Ronald Halverson, Sunday School student. For the musical portion of the service the church choir sang "Built on a Rock" by Lindeman and the Sunday School sang the hymn, "My Church, My Church."

A special guest at the services was Hans Iva, South San Gabriel, who is the general contractor for the present building project. He greeted the congregation at the close of the ground-breaking services.
