GARDENERS CHECKLIST

1. There's still time to set lawns out, though you'll have to hurry. They don't like staying out of the ground as long as other bulbs.
2. Provide support for Winted Sweet Peas as they sprout. Chicken wire or strings stretched between poles is fine.
3. For a big splash of quick color in your garden this month, yellow marguerites are a good bet. And don't overlook container-grown chrysanthemums for another.
4. When setting out bedding plants for winter bloom, don't break the cardinal rule of choosing a well-drained spot. Sadden roots are a real threat to winter annuals.
5. Camellias tend to set too many buds. If you want bigger and better blooms, disbud now. If you leave buds of different sizes, you'll have a longer period of bloom from each shrub.

This assignment was made under a special program of the Army under which young engineers called into military service may be assigned engineering work at Army installations. Qualifications are high and include a college degree in an appropriate field. As the principal laboratory of the Corps of Engineers in the fields of hydraulics, concrete research, soil mechanics and flexible pavement design, the Waterways Experiment Station is engaged in a vast research and development program.
