Absentee Ballot Deadline Set

Deadline on applications for absentee ballots for the Oct. 14 election is next Thursday, Oct. 8.

Persons expecting to be away or physically unable to attend the polls on that date are advised to get their applications from Administration Offices of the Torrance Unified School District, 2335 Plaza del Amo, prior to next Thursday.

Upon completing the application, the voter is required to mail it to the Registrar of Voters, 609 N. Spring St., Los Angeles 12.

Detailed instructions for voting will be sent with the ballot upon receipt of the completed application. The absentee ballot must be in the hands of the Registrar of Voters on or before election day, Oct. 14.
