## Vel's Ford to Show New Models Friday

The 1959 Ford car line, which already has received an award at the Brussels World's Fair for styling elegance, will go on display at Vel's Ford, 1420 Cabrillo, and Pacific Coast Hwy. and Hawthorne in Walleria tomorrow, it was announced here yesterday by Vel Miletich, president of the agency.

"Each piece of body sheet metal in the 1959 Ford has been changed to reflect the good taste of the Thunderbird—America's most successfully styled car," Miletich said. He pointed out that the noted fashion authority, Comite Francaise de l'Elegance, had awarded the new Ford a gold medal for styling in Brussels. It is the first time in history that an American automobile has received the award, he said.

THE 1959 LINE will include 17 models ranging from the Custom 300 series through six station wagon models to the

Fairlane and Fairlane 500 series. All 1959 Fords have a wheelbase of 118 inches, and an overall length of 206 inches. The 1959 Ford has something for everyone, Miletich reports.

**FOR THE MECHANICALLY minded,** there is the new two-speed Fordomatic automatic transmission, which has eliminated 105 parts and uses an aluminum transmission case and bell housing; there's a choice of four modern engines with full-flow oil filter, which permits oil changes only each 4000 miles; the new Equi-Lock differential which provides positive traction under conditions of poor footing; Magic-Aire heater, aluminum muffler, foot-operated parking brake, and a super-compact finish that doesn't require waxing.

That no waxing is there is something to consider, Miletich said.

**FOR THOSE WITH an eye to style,** the Ford also has that, the dealer said.

Crediting the feminine influence on straight lines, clean surfaces and crisp styling, Ford designers have come up with a dignified approach to automobile design in the 1959 Fords.

Side trims have been used sparingly, and the interiors have been finished in smart, durable and livable fabrics.

The exterior paints are in softer tones this year, and include such colors as gunsmoke grey, surf blue, ashwood green, torch red, Tahitian bronze, inca gold, and Indian turquoise.

### GARDENERS CHECKLIST

1. Don't let the summer crop of snails and slugs catch you unawares. Get busy with pellets or bait now. Set the bait in small piles. Pellets may be scattered, but are more effective when also bunched in mounds of several pellets each.
2. You can green up the fall lawn and give it new life with a light feeding or complete lawn food. Water is thoroughly after spreading the fertilizer.
3. Perennial plants can be divided now if clumps are crowded and bloom was less spectacular this year. Don't try to pull the clumps apart, but use a sharp knife and take small divisions, preferably from the outside edges.
4. Chrysanthemums in full bloom are available at nurseries in gallon cans. These may be sunk in the ground to fill bare spots in the garden.
5. Evergreen shrubs and trees are best planted now so that winter rains will get them off to a good start.
