

Saxons Meet Redondo Seahawks In Gridiron Classic Friday Night

Coach Vince McCollough and his Seahawk eleven will come to Torrance tomorrow night as the North High Saxons, fresh from their 6-0 win over Mira Costa, play their first home game of the season. Kick-off time is 8 p.m. on the Torrance High School Stadium field.

For the first time in four years of North football, the Saxons will be favored to win the encounter, according to sideline dopsters. The Redondo gridsmen, under a new head coach and a new offensive system, will employ a wing "T." Coach Bob Shoup's Saxons, who won the first game in their football history by a 6-0 defeat of Redondo last season, will be in top shape for the contest, and with Ends Steve Mearing and Dennis Berry in the line may take to the air in an effort to give North High another win.

"This is a serious emergency."
These are the words used by Community Chest officials to describe a situation in which the Los Angeles Red Feather agency must have an additional one million dollars from the annual campaign which starts Monday.

Should the drive fall, the main sufferers will be children, many of whom are waiting for modern care and preventive treatment provided by the 167 health and welfare services of the Community Chest.

"Yearly gains made by your Chest have not been enough to meet growing needs," officials say.

At least \$222,000 is needed for health services — hospitals, clinics, mostly for children, and home nursing; \$411,000 more is required for child care in foster homes and institutions; and \$871,000 is the additional minimum figure for youth services preventing delinquency.

"Every family as well as every firm is asked to open wallet and purse a little wider this year to help make up the million more needed to wipe out waiting lines," officials appeal.
