

Sand, Gravel Removal On Schedule, Supervisor Says

Removal of about 600,000 cubic yards of excess sub-grade material as a part of the County Flood Control District's water conservation program for Dominguez Gap is progressing according to schedule, Supervisor Burton W. Chace said today.

District plans call for use of the area as a water replenishment measure in combating the continued downward movement of the underground water table, Chace said. Made up of porous sands and gravels, the soil is particularly suitable for the development of spreading grounds.

CHACE EXPLAINED that the spreading grounds are located on both the east and west side of the Los Angeles River and run between Del Amo Blvd. and 23rd St. Easting performed by L.A. Assoc Construction Co. of Long Beach.

The beach city firm with a bid of \$63,000 was low among proposals submitted recently to Flood Control Chief H. E. Hedger.

projects 129 and 130, slated for early construction, will utilize the outside spreading basin as an outlet, Chace said. A pumping plant is planned in connection with Project 130 to facilitate drainage into

the main river channel. Highlighting the importance of this phase of the district's activities is the growing water shortage in Southern California and the fact that the area will depend upon underground reservoirs for 80 per cent of its total water supply, Chace added.
