Sermon Text Deals With Salvation

"Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven," sets forth in the words of the Apostle Matthew (7:21) the Golden Text and the central idea of the Lesson-Sermon "Probation After Death" to be given in all Christian Science churches Sunday.

As the subject unfolds there will be read from "Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures" by Mary Baker Eddy this passage, "Perfection is gained only by perfection. . . . The sin and error which possess us at the instant of death do not cease at that moment, but endure until the death of these errors" (p. 296).
