**Streets to Get Signs To Freeway**

Directional signs to guide motorists to the Harbor freeway are soon to be placed on major north-south streets in county unincorporated territory, Supervisor Kenneth Hahn announced this week.

Signs will be placed on Main St., Avxiod Blvd., San Pedro St., Broadway, Normandie and Western Aves., and Crenshaw Blvd.

Hahn requested the County Road Department to install the signs so that motorists wishing to use the Harbor freeway from the southern part of the County would have adequate directions.

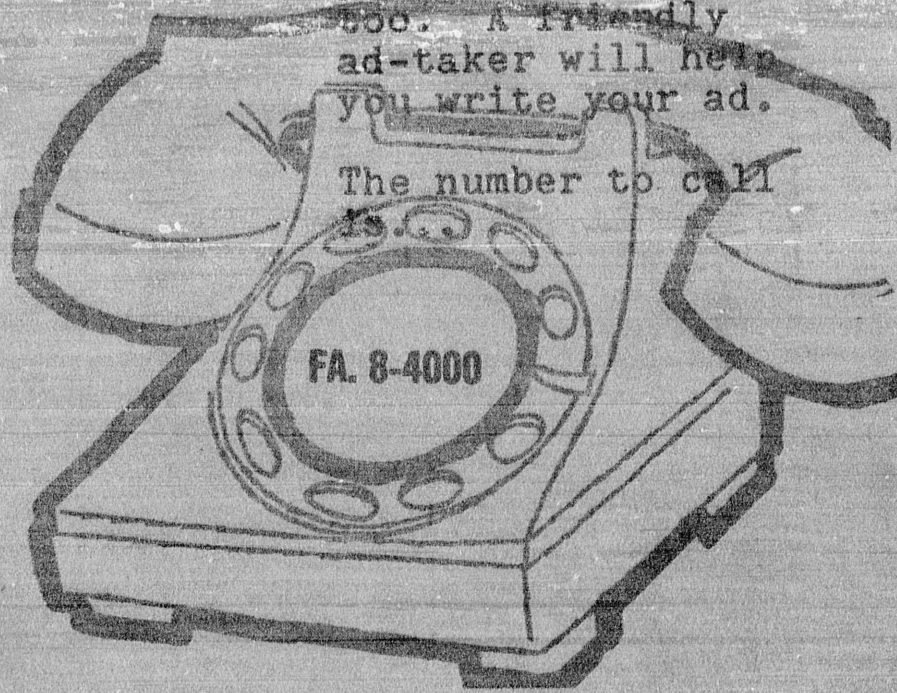
