

Cecil King Asks Area Voters to Top Nation in Ballots Cast

Congressman Cecil H. King today called upon the 322,592 registered voters of the 17th congressional district in the United States.

In his pre-election appeal, King said:

"In keeping with the fact that our district is one of the largest populated congressional districts in California and that today we have the largest registration of voters in its history, Republicans and Democrats alike should take pride in these facts, and turn out more ballots on this coming Election Day than ever before."

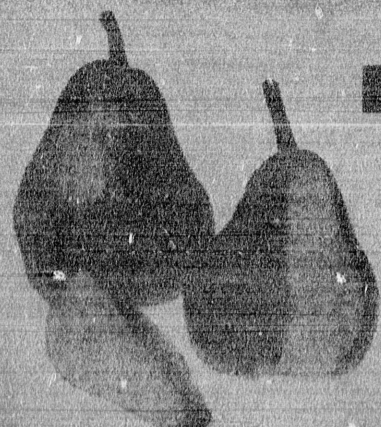

Rig Made Here Used to Drill Large Gas Well

A National Type 80-B Rig, manufactured by National Supply Co., 1524 Border Ave., was used in drilling the world's highest oil well recently.

The well, located 160 miles northwest of Edmonton, Alberta, Canada, has a calculated open-flow potential of 1.5 billion cubic feet per day. The two largest previous wells, both in the United States, have potentials of about 1 billion cubic feet per day.

Known as Berland River A-8, the well was drilled by Reading and Bates, Ltd., for British American Oil Co., Ltd., and Shell Oil Co. of Canada, Ltd. It has been called Canada's biggest discovery of 1955.

Production at 12,014-12,235 feet is the deepest production of any kind in Canada.

The rig is one of the first to use a new auxiliary draw works drive developed by National Supply. In addition to the rig, National furnished the wellhead equipment and Spang casing and tubing.

Drilled to 12,677 feet, the well was plugged back to 12,465 feet. Casing was set at 12,008 feet.

Chase Attends Bankers' Meet
