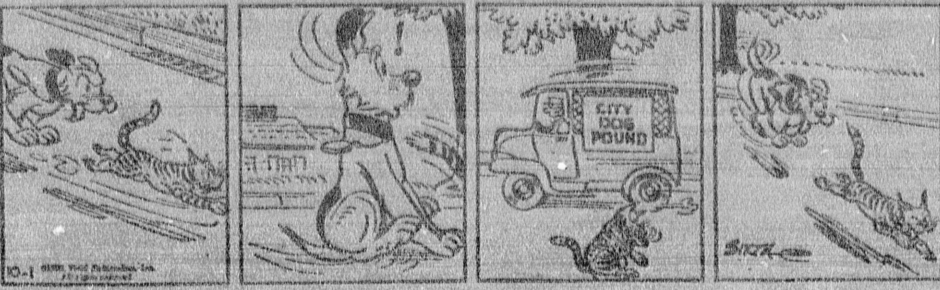

Switchboard On Wheels To Be Viewed at Open House



A mobile communications center, designed for handling phone calls during a disaster, will be unveiled to Torrance residents at an open house to be held by Pacific Telephone Co. at 1307 Cravens Avenue Thursday and Friday, Nov. 13 and 14.

Guided tours will be conducted from 1 to 9 p.m. both days by Gloria Walker and Fred Thacker.

Built into an oversize hot-rod trailer, the communications unit contains five switchboards capable of handling calls for a total of 600 telephones.

According to telephone manager Dick Pyle this would be sufficient for the emergency needs of any community in the

Los Angeles area. Within minutes, he said, the rolling central office could be tied to an open exchange cable and become operative.

The emergency trailer has undergone exhaustive field tests, proving that it can operate either alone or with other emergency units. In a recent operation the trailer, a microwave radio mobile unit and a multiple sending unit bridged the communications gap of some 30 miles between Los Angeles and Hollywood.

The mobile unit carries its own batteries or it can be hooked up to commercial power. Measuring 33 feet in length and weighing six tons, it is operated by six telephone operators and two technicians.

Harbor District In First Place In Chest Drive

Harbor Area Community Chest is in first place in the current associated cities campaign, according to George M. Hawley, campaign head, who today released the first official progress report of the 1958 drive.

To date Harbor Area has reached nearly 18 per cent of its goal in second place in the South East Area, with 18 per cent of its quota already in. The Valley Area is a close third, reporting better than 14 per cent pledged.

With the residential portion

of the local drive getting under way today, workers on the advanced gift committee already have brought in 66 per cent of their total goal for Torrance, San Pedro, Wilmington, and Gardena.

When informed of Harbor Area's leading the drive at this time, Area Chairman Glenn Kuger pointed out that Harbor Area was the first of the associated cities to make 100 per cent of its goal last year.
